**Orientation:** Thursday, August 25, 2011  
9:00am to 11:00am  
Casual meeting over coffee to prepare for sail week (safety, attire, course content, etc.)

**Sailing Class:** Monday, August 29 to Friday, September 2, 2011\*  
10:00 am – 1:00 pm  
\* NOTE: In the event of severe weather, the classes will be rescheduled for Sept. 6 through Sept. 10.

**Location:** Sarasota Sailing Squadron

Sarasota, Florida

**Fee:** Sailing Instruction **\$187.25**  
Fee includes sailing classes, use of boat, manual, graduation celebration and taxes. It also includes \$25 toward temporary membership to the Sarasota Sailing Squadron, which covers the period from September through December 2011. If you are already an SSS member, you may subtract \$25 and pay \$162.25 instead.

**Dues:** Membership in Luffing Lassies (active status) **\$60.00**  
Payable on September 2, 2011 after the completion of the sailing classes

**Boat Rental:** Boat Rental is available on a yearly basis if you do not have your own  
**Pram/Opti** **\$220.00**  
**Sunfish** **\$275.00**

The yearly rental fee includes a 7% sales tax and is due September 2, 2011 (or if you prefer it may be payable in two equal payments due September, 2, 2011 and December 31, 2011).

**Clothing/Gear:** **Life Jacket**

- This will be worn at all times on a boat and in the water
- Preferably the vest style that your arms go through and zips or buckles in the front
- Can be purchased at West Marine, Wal-Mart, Target, etc.

**Bathing Suit** – you will be getting wet every day  
**T-shirt & Shorts** – to wear over your bathing suit while you are sailing  
**Closed-toe Rubber Soled Shoes**

- Shoes will be worn at all times on shore, in the water, and on a boat
- Preferably old sneakers or water shoes
- No Crocks, Sandals, or Flip-Flops
